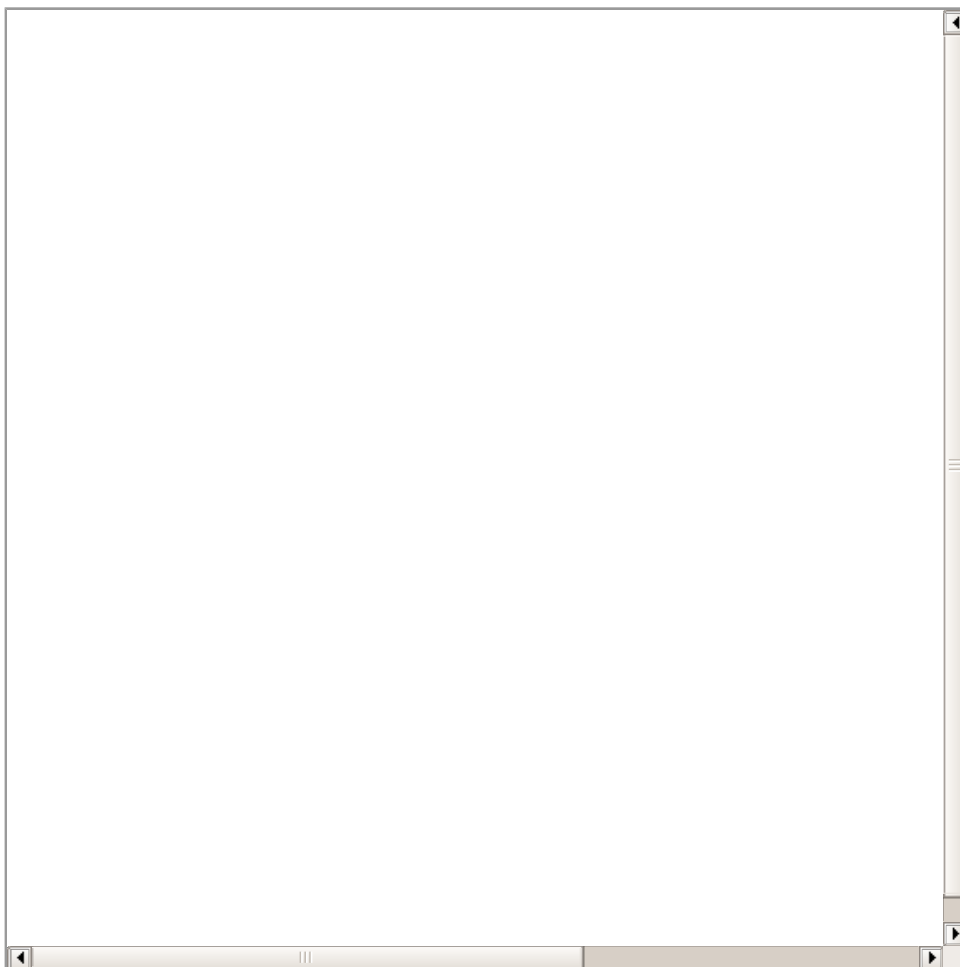
In this module, we will get introduced to the idea behind a black hole. When we say that black holes are very powerful, what does that exactly mean? How do they differ from other powerful objects?
